	 Until the time of the drawing of lots, in case of gymnasts' withdrawal, the FIG will invite the next eligible gymnasts as per the "replacement policy" outlined in these rules. Once the draw has been conducted, in case of gymnasts' withdrawal or in case places remain "empty", the Organising Member Federation is entitled to nominate and invite gymnast(s) from its country or a country of its choice to fill those "empty" places (limited to maximum 2 gymnasts per country). It is understood that such invitations must be made through the respective member federation and that the FIG must be informed. These gymnasts will receive World Cup points, medals and prize money FIG Competition II rules will be applied for vault. In case that less than four federations participate, no World Cup points, no medals and no prize money will be given. 	The participation of these nominative qualified gymnasts (places 1-7) must be confirmed as soon as possible, but no later than 3 months prior to the competition. Failure to confirm in due time will automatically result in the FIG inviting the replacement as outlined here below. In case a qualified gymnast does not accept to participate in the All-Around World Cup competition or withdraws, he/she is replaced, in order of priority, as follows:			
	By the next ranked gymnast (places 8-12, nominative places) in C-II at the previous World Championships / Olympic Games*. These places must be confirmed as soon as possible, but no later than 2 months (nominative registration) prior to the competition.			

• By a gymnast from the best ranked federations in C-IV at the previous World Championships/Olympic Games*. Invitation and selection from these national federations will be done directly by the Organizing Member Federation in consultation with the respective member federation. They must be contacted respecting the ranking order of the results of C-IV of the previous World Championships/Olympic Games. These places are allocated to the National Federation, and must be confirmed as soon as possible, but no later than 2 months (nominative registration) prior to the competition. Organizers of World Cup competitions are obliged to send minimum one male and one female competitor to all All-Around World Cup competitions, if invited according to this replacement rule.

*Note For the 2013-2014 All-Around World Cup season, the gymnasts' qualification will be based on the 2013 World Championships results.

In any case, no federation may participate with more than 2 male and 2 female gymnasts

<u>Note</u>: in the overall interest of All-Around World Cup Series and for unforeseen cases, the FIG Presidential Commission may award an additional "Wild Card" for an exceptional gymnast.

SIZE OF DELEGATION AND FIG LICENSE

Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnast' Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. The maximum size of the invited delegation is as follows:

AGE LIMITS

Age Limit for MAG:

18 years (born in 1995 or before for the World Cups taking place in 2013)

Age Limit for WAG:

16 years (born in 1997 or before for the World Cups taking place in 2013)

JUDGES AND JURIES

The number of Judges' Panels may be decided by the Organizing Member Federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges.

The Judges' Panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates. The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts.

Each Judges' Panel must be composed of 2 D judges, min. 5 E judges, plus 1 Supervisor. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for Time and Line Judges).

The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by October, 25th 2013.

The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 man and 1 woman). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost (in terms of international and local travel, accommodation, and meals) of the Organizing Member Federation. In case of a tie in the World Cup Ranking List after the last respective competitions of the series, the tie will not be broken. Should the Organising Member Federations decide to create a jack-pot, then this jack-pot shall be distributed according to the special rules set up by the Organising Member Federations approved by FIG.
