***NOTE 1:** All Federation must bring at least one FIG International brevet Judge for this competition. Those Federations that not send at least one judge, must pay a fee of



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USD\$1.000.00 to invite a neutral judge. The national federation must inform and pay the fee to PAGU at most in the deadline of the nominative registration.

***NOTE 2:** The PAGU WAG and MAG Technical Committees Members can participate as additional judges of their own federation. These judges have the same conditions of accreditation, accommodation and meals of the other official delegation members.

NOTE 3: It will be allowed the accreditation of a reserve junior gymnast for the WAG and MAG junior teams, but their accreditation will be considered as an additional accreditation outside of the official delegation and must be pay to the organization.

The reserve gymnast must use the time that have to the training his/her team.

The cost of the accreditation for additional person (Coaches, Team Managers, Doctors, Physiatrist, and Junior Reserve Gymnasts) will be USD\$ 100.00 each one. This accreditation will allow that person to access the different areas according his/her function, to the local transportation and the Closure Dinner.

REGULATIONS

Championship Program: Concourse I and Apparatus Finals (Concourse III).

Junior: The concourse (I) will establish the results of the All Around and teams winners. The format of the competition will be 4-4-3, and the team score will be calculated with the 3 best scores per apparatus.

Apparatus Senior: The concourse (I) will establish the gymnasts that will compete in the apparatus finals. In the concourse (I) can participate at most three gymnasts per federation per apparatus, but only two of best ranked gymnasts per apparatus per federation can qualify to the concourse (III).

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GYMNASTS' LICENSE
