CANCELLATION POLICY	Cancelation until March 12 th , at a 100% rate refund and later, no refund.		
FINAL BANQUET	The Final Banquet will be held on Sunday, 25 th March 2012 at 19h30 at Lindner Congress Hotel and will be free of charge for all the delegation members.		
	Every Delegation will receive an invitation once all financial issues between the OC and the delegation guests are duly solved.		
FIG TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND	The FIG Technical Delegate and EC member (if applicable) will be designated by the FIG.		
EC MEMBER	The FIG Technical Delegates will serve as Presidents of the Superior Jury.		
JUDGES AND JURIES	The Apparatus Jury (or Juries) will be composed as follows:2 D judges, minimum 4 E judges, plus 1 Supervisor		
	The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts.		
	Failure to provide judges as mentioned above will result in an OC charge of 2'000 CHF to the federation concerned (non refundable). This fine must be paid to the OC by 23 rd February.		
	The number of Apparatus Juries (judges' panels) will be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for time and line judges).		
	The Apparatus Juries are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw will be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates.		
	The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation will propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 man and 1 woman). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.
