COMPETITION FORMAT

Qualification Phase

a) Qualification for finals

- There is no team participation.
- All gymnasts that participate in the qualification phase will qualify for the final, as long as they earned a qualifying score in both of the required routines.

The competition will take place in 1 subdivision, according to the draw that will take place at the Technical Meeting.

b) Finals

- Gymnasts that have participated in the qualification phase will compete as long as they have earned a qualifying score in both of the required routines.
- Gymnasts may only execute one free routine.
- In the event of a tie in final results, there will be no tie-breaker.

Competition order will be defined through a draw that will take place during the Technical Meeting.

COMPETITORS' AGES

Athletes must be at least **17 years old** by December 31st, 2014 (born in 1997).

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

In accordance to the quota set by CACSO, the Trampoline Gymnastics competition will have a maximum of **12** athletes: 6 women and 6 men.

Each NOC may register a maximum of 2 athletes, one male and one female, as long as the qualification criteria stipulated by UPAG for the Trampoline Gymnastics competition at the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014 are fulfilled.



VERACRUZ 2014 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

- a) Gymnasts must have an FIG license that is valid in 2014.
- b) Mexico, as host country may enter 2 athletes in each announced event.
- c) UPAG will extend an invitation to Cuba, Colombia, Puerto Rico, Venezuela and the Dominican Republic, who may enter 2 athletes in each announced event.
- d) UPAG will notify the NOCs and the Organizing Committee of the final slot distribution no later than **March 1st, 2014**, so the NOCs may be able to comply with the CACSO regulations on entry by name and number.

Qualification system approval

UPAG's Trampoline Gymnastics Technical Committee reviewed and approved this qualification system May 13th, 2013.



TECHNICAL MEETING

- The Technical Meeting will take place **Sunday, November 23rd** at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Veracruz at a time to be defined.
- Up to two representatives from each NOC will be able to assist this Technical Meeting.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Heads of Team at the Sports Information Center at the Central American and Caribbean Village upon their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Organizing Committee's Competition Manager for Trampoline Gymnastics will preside the meeting, which shall take place in Spanish and English.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Technical personnel (Technical Director and apparatus supervisors) will be the members of the technical committee of UPAG. Judges must comply with UPAG's regulations, if there are not enough judges who fulfill these requirements, an invitation will be extended to neutral judges until the required number of officials is reached. The competition director will be designated by FMG.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests and appeals will be resolved in accordance to what is established in FIG's and UPAG's Technical Regulations (change in protest price).

DRAW

Order of participation will be defined through a draw that will take place at the Technical Meeting.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

Medal ceremonies will take place according to CACSO's General Regulations, Chapter XIII.

Individual Events:

- First place: Gold medal and diploma
- Second place: Silver medal and diploma
- Third place: Bronze medal and diploma

COMPETITION VENUE

The Trampoline Gymnastics competition will take place at the Veracruz Multi-Sports center.
