<p><b>FEDERATIONS INVITED AND REPLACEMENT POLICY</b></p>	<p>The organizing member federation may invite FIG member federations in good standing at their discretion, but must invite at least all Member Federations who had gymnasts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- ranked 1-8 in C-III at the previous World Championships*</li> <li>- ranked 1-8 from the 2013 World Cup Ranking List for Individual Apparatus</li> </ul> <p><i>* For the 2014 series, the gymnasts' invitation will be based on the results of the 2013 World Championships</i></p>																																
<p><b>PARTICIPATION AND FIG LICENSE</b></p>	<p>Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts' licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. <b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee (approved by the FIG) is of 30 EUR per gymnast.</p> <p>The payment of the entry fee must accompany the Definitive registration or January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014 at the very latest.</p>								
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>At the time of arrival, every delegation will be brought to the accreditation centre in the Official hotel where they will receive a welcome package including all relevant information and the accreditations, which will allow access into the training and competition halls. The accreditation is personal and non-transferable and must be used at all times. In case of loss, the Head of Competition must be contacted immediately.</p>								
<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	<p>The Individual Apparatus Competitions for World Challenge Cup competitions consist of: Qualifications and Apparatus Finals</p> <p><u>Qualifications:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per country on each apparatus.</li> <li>▪ The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to add (only for the qualifications) “hors concours” competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official competitors of the Organizing Member Federation, they must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and they cannot qualify for the Finals. They are not eligible to receive World Cup points, they must not appear on the official results lists and they will have to start first at every apparatus.</li> <li>▪ The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name a max. of “4 hors concours” competitors in Women’s Artistic Gymnastics and a max. of “4 hors concours” competitors in Men’s Artistic Gymnastics for a total of 8 “hors concours” gymnasts (i.e. while one “hors concours” gymnast can compete on more than one apparatus, not more than one “hors concours” gymnast can compete on an apparatus).</li> <li>▪ FIG Competition III rules will be applied for vault.</li> <li>▪ In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. Nevertheless, the gymnasts not qualified for the Finals and with the same final score will receive the same World Cup Points.</li> </ul> <p><u>Finals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The best eight gymnasts per apparatus from the qualifications qualify for the Finals</li> <li>▪ Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per country and each apparatus.</li> <li>▪ In addition, the Organizing Member Federation has the right to a limited number of Wild Cards to guarantee the participation of the Host Country gymnasts in the Finals (maximum 1 man and 1 woman gymnast only at one apparatus each).</li> <li>▪ These “Wild Card Gymnasts” must have participated at the respective apparatus in the qualification.</li> <li>▪ “Wild Card Gymnasts” will receive medals, prize money and World Cup</li> </ul>								

	<p>points.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ FIG Competition III rules will be applied for vault.</li> <li>▪ In case of a tie at any place, the tie will not be broken. <b>DRAWING OF LOTS</b>	The gymnasts' drawing of lots will be directed by the FIG Technical Delegate and take place at the Orientation meeting of the event in accordance with the procedures established.

	<p>Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Slovenia. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014 to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance. (Except for gymnasts and judges.)</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 25 € per person/day.</p>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014</p>
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>Delegations that book their accommodation through the OC will be able to use the local transportation free of charge on the following routes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ljubljana airport (Letališče Jožeta Pučnika) or the Ljubljana railway station to the hotel and back on the official arrival and departure days.</li> <li>- The hotel to the competition/training venue and back</li> </ul> <p>Transportation from other nearby international airports (Zagreb, Trieste, Venice) can be arranged at additional cost. 	<p>The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the OC as soon as possible but no later than by February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014, the number of certain type of hotel rooms is limited, therefore they will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis.</p> <p><b>The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members (see exception herein below).</b></p> <p>The full costs for the accommodation and meals must be paid to the OC by February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014 as follows:</p> <p>At the time of the Definitive entry - January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2014 (2 months prior to the event) provisional reservations are to be placed with the LOC which must be accompanied by 50% of the Accommodation and meals costs. Entries without the payment of the 50% of the Accommodation and meals costs will be considered as invalid and will be refused. The remaining 50% of the Accommodation costs must be paid by February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014.</p> <p>In case of room cancellations until January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014 the OC will refund the complete amount of annulled rooms. In case of room cancellations until February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014 the OC will refund 50 % of the amount of annulled rooms. In case of room cancellations after February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014, no claims of refunds will be accepted.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation must pay for the Accommodation expenses for the gymnasts ranked 1-3, per apparatus, competing in the event from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- previous World Championships* (see note above)</li> <li>- the 2013 World Cup Ranking List</li> </ul>
<b>MEALS</b>	<p>All the accommodation packages include breakfast.</p> <p>Other meals (lunch and dinner) will also be available at a price of 15 € per person per meal (i.e. one dinner 15 €, one lunch 15 €). Meal forms must be returned to the OC by February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014 at the very latest.</p> <p><b>The invited participating federations must pay for the meals expenses of their delegation members (see exception herein below).</b></p> <p>The Deadlines for meals reservations as well as their payment are the same as it is for the accommodation. Cancellation policy for accommodation is applicable for meals as well and is stated in the previous section above.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation must pay for the meals expenses, including full board, for the gymnasts ranked 1-3, per apparatus, competing in the event from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- previous World Championships* (see note above)</li> <li>- the 2013 World Cup Ranking List</li> </ul>
<b>FINAL BANQUET</b>	<p>The final banquet will be free of charge for the participants booking their arrangements through the OC.</p> <p>For other interested parties tickets will be available at the cost of 30 €.</p>
<b>FIG TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND EC MEMBER</b>	<p>The FIG Technical Delegate and EC member (if applicable) will be designated by the FIG.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Delegates will serve as Presidents of the Superior Jury.</p>
<b>JUDGES AND PANELS</b>	<p>Each Judge's panel will be composed as follows:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 D judges, minimum 4 E judges, plus 1 Supervisor</li> </ul> <p>The number of judges' panels will be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for time and line judges).</p> <p>The judges' panels are set up by a draw from the judges present at the event. The draw must be directed by the MAG and WAG Technical Delegates. The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and one qualified WAG judge if they participate with female gymnasts.</p> <p><b>The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by February 7<sup>th</sup> 2014.</b></p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the Organizing Member Federation must propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 man and 1 woman). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG Office in consultation with the TC Presidents concerned will invite these judges at the cost (in terms of international and local travel, accommodation and meals) of the Organizing Member Federation. For additional judge's requirements see the Specific Judges' Rules.</p>																				
<b>VIDEO CONTROL SYSTEM</b>	<p>Should IRCOS not be available, the Organizing Member Federation will provide another video control system which allows to treat inquiries and records all exercises of the competition in a quality which allows to judge the exercises.</p>

- If 5 or more World Cup Competitions take place per year, the best 4 are counted

- If 4 or 3 World Cup Competitions take place per year all points are counted

A special award ceremony must be held at the last Individual Apparatus World Cup/World Challenge Cup competition of the year in which the Individual Apparatus World Cup and World Challenge Cup winners shall receive a Cup.

In case of a tie in the respective World Cup Ranking Lists after the last respective competitions of the year, the tie will not be broken.


