Entry of Reserve Gymnast**

Dear Presidents of Participating Federations,

Thank you very much for participating in the 6<sup>th</sup> Senior Artistic Gymnastics Asian Championships.

The Organizing Committee, in consultation with AGU, has decided to allow the entry of reserve gymnast in accordance with the delegation size of ART World Championships to make the Championships more excited.

Approved Entries pertaining to Reserve Gymnast:

- One reserve gymnast for each MAG and WAG
- One additional coach for each MAG and WAG
- AD cards for those above are provided for free of charge as the other participants

Rules pertaining to the inclusion of a reserve gymnast are as follows;

- 60 min prior to the beginning of each phase of the competition (with medical certificate verified by the official FIG/LOC medical doctor), a gymnast can be substituted. The substitute shall take exactly the same place as the replaced gymnast.
- 24 hours prior to the beginning of Competition IV, federations can replace gymnasts, but only from the max. 6+1 gymnasts accredited at the time of 24 hours prior to Competition I.
- In Competition I if an injury occurs during warm-up time, or during the Competitions, a substitution is only allowed if the Superior Jury is immediately informed and if the replacement is designated exactly into the place drawn.
- Qualified gymnasts for Competition III may be replaced by their NF with one of its other gymnasts at their discretion provided that the said replacement has obtained a superior result to that of the first gymnast of reserve. The replacement gymnast will fill the position in the draw of the replaced gymnast.

The revised directive, definitive and nominative forms are enclosed.

Please kindly use the revised forms for the definitive and nominative entries.

<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing.  Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU, the FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organising Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.	
<b>AGE LIMITS</b>	Age limit for MAG: 18 years (born in 1997 or before) Age limit for WAG: 16 years (born in 1999 or before)	
<b>FIG LICENSE</b>	All gymnasts must present a valid FIG License in order to be eligible to participate in an international competition.	
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.	
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	The accreditation will take place upon arrival of the delegations.  Together with the nominative registration, the delegations must send to the LOC a passport photo of each delegation member(in electronic format). The specifications of each photo must be as follows:  - File name: Federation's code_LAST NAME_First name (e.g. "JPN_LAST NAME_First name") - File format: .jpg or .jpeg - Dimensions: min. 210 X 270 pixels, max. 420 X 540 pixels (width X height) - File size: not bigger than 150kb

<b>COMPETITION FORMAT</b>	The competitions will be conducted according to FIG's <i>Technical Regulations 2015</i> including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, Competitions I, II, III and IV, where relevant, with the following modifications.  The competition consists of Men's and Women's Team Final, All-Around Final and Apparatus Qualification and Final.  <u>Team Final, All-Around Final, Apparatus Qualification (Competition I, II, IV) – Competition Day1:WAG, Competition Day2:MAG</u>  Team and All-Around Final will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Final.  A Team shall have not more than 5 gymnasts to compete on each apparatus and 4 highest scores will be taken into account for the Team total.  For men, the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatus.  For women, the competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatus.  To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is	

based on the average of the two scores.

Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.

The total scores of the gymnasts, who perform on all the apparatus in competition I, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation).

No tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Team and All-Around Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie is not broken.

In the qualifications for the Apparatus Final, in case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR will apply.

**Apparatus Finals (Competition III) - Competition Day3:WAG/MAG**

The top 8 gymnasts on each apparatus from the Apparatus Qualification shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (Competition III) (with maximum 2 gymnasts per Federation).

No tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Apparatus Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie is not broken.

**\*Award Ceremonies**  
Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. These gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.

The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts/teams from each competition according to the result rankings.

Tied gymnasts /teams will receive the same colored medal.
